




Life Wins! Frameable Poster

Annual Awards Dinner Featured Babylon Bee CEO Seth Dillon and U.S. Senator Marco Rubio


This year's annual policy awards dinner was a unique success. Over 500 supporters attended and among them were 24 legislators who came and publicly received our First Principles Award.

Over 1,200 Floridians watched the virtual forum where President John Stemberger interviewed US Senator Marco Rubio who gave a briefing on issues in Congress.






